## Confirmation of Agenda

- o CA added an item to the agenda to include resigning a deed.
- GB moved to accept agenda as amended; TT 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - Motion approved unanimously.

## Deed Resigning

- The original deed for parcel H2, donated to the Town by Crabtree Development as part of its settlement agreement with the EPA and signed by ConCom on 2/15/11, was lost in BOS office.
- o ConCom signed the replacement deed.

# • Meeting Minutes Approval

- o GB moved to accept the minutes for 1/26/12 as written; TT 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - Motion approved unanimously.

### ConCom Organization

- o BD suggested a Vice-Chair be elected.
- o JG moved to nominate GB as Vice-Chair; WB 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Motion approved 4-1 (GB voting against himself).
  - BD said GB's service was duly noted, along with his recalcitrance.

### CA Updates

- ConCom Budget
  - \$554.84 remains in the budget for this fiscal year.
    - CA suggested items to consider ordering:
      - o a box or two of letterhead envelopes
      - o a couple of cases of paper for photocopying
      - o ink cartridges for the color printer
- ConCom badges
  - The Fire Department now has the capability to produce identification badges.
  - CA will have ConCom join a group purchase of badges which will be made in March.
    - CA said ConCom members' use of identification badges will alleviate complaints of trespassing.
- o The Willows, Enforcement Order
  - CA said things are moving along.



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- The developer has submitted its Wetlands Mitigation Plan for remediation to MassDEP.
- Phil Nadeau, of MassDEP will hold a negotiation meeting with the developer on 2/27 to formulate the Consent Agreement for moving forward.
- o Pingry Hill
  - Steve Mullaney, of SJ Mullaney Engineering Inc., submitted NOIs for 4 lots.
  - The first Public Hearing for these NOIs will be at ConCom's next meeting on 2/24.
    - BD said site walks will likely have to wait until spring budding in order for ConCom to adequately be able to identify wetland plants, etc. -- unless the developer solicits the services of a third-party expert.
  - CA noted a question about lot 50A (272 Old Farm Way).
    - The written application indicates the building of a backyard retaining wall just 3 ft. from BVW.
    - Looking at the plans, it appears this may be a typo, but ConCom will have to clarify this at the Hearing.

  - Document editing continued.
