• Meeting Minutes Approval

- \circ GB moved to approve 06/26/08 meeting minutes, with minor edits on page 3; JG 2nd. Motion approved unan.

Announcements

- BD: Purple loosestrife beetles are doing well in the wetland near his home.
- BD: CA is tracking her hours on a weekly basis to help stay on top of the budget.
- o JG: Indicated she will be available after next week to assist CA in the office, if needed.
- o BD: Left a voicemail with attorneys for Pond View re: unresolved CR issues.
- BD: Icehouse Dam Commission will follow Shirley's recommendation and will ask Icehouse Partners to file NOI for the annual maintenance activities at the dam.

Public Hearing (cont'd): NOI – 12 Willow Road (Hybricon)

- o CA forwarded draft Special Conditions for review.
 - Several of the standard Special Conditions are missing, and the numbering begins with 1 rather than 19 (1-18 are the Standard Conditions in the DEP Form).

- o TT: MassDevelopment and MassWildlife will conduct a second presentation on rare species and other issues related to North Post redevelopment.

- o JG: Suggested holding a public informational meeting as a follow-up to the pond mailings.
 - Could invite DEP and ACEC representatives to participate.
