Meeting Minutes Approval

- Commission reviewed/amended meeting minutes from 08/09/07 and 08/23/07.
- GB moved to approve meeting minutes as amended; DB seconded.
 - Motion approved unanimously.
- Payables
 - Invoice for legal notices in Lowell Sun re: Aquatic Control Technology (ACT) pond weed treatment, in the amount of \$226.29.
 - GB moved to approve payment of the invoice; DB seconded.

- Commission reviewed the draft Order of Conditions (OOC) and draft Special Conditions with the applicant, Mark Velardi.
- Mr. Velardi agreed to abide by the conditions as written.
- GB moved to approve the OOC and Special Conditions; DB seconded.
 - Motion approved unanimously.
- GB moved to close the hearing; DB seconded.
 - Motion approved unanimously.
- Continued Public Hearing NOI re: DPW Grove Pond Wells Replacement
 - Special Conditions were approved last meeting, 08/23/07.
 - OOC form is not completed.

 - Motion approved unanimously.
- BD will complete OOC form and forward to members for signatures over the weekend.
- GB moved to close the hearing; DB seconded.
 - Motion approved unanimously.

• Discussion re: 80 Sandy Pond Road, Removal of Cesspool

- Betty Harrison, current homeowner, needs to remove an old cesspool behind the house before she can sell the property.
- BD spoke to Amanda Veinotte of Natural Heritage & Endangered Species Program (NHESP) and was informed that the project would fall under MEPA review.
- GB to follow up on MEPA issue.

• Conservation Administrator (CA) Position

- BD read a memo from Shaun Suhoski, Town Administrator, re: Personnel Board approval of the Conservation Administrator position at Grade 8 (\$19.00 \$19.87 per hour).
 - This equates to roughly 11.22 11.74 hours per week.
- Reference check for Becky DaSilva-Conde of N. Chelmsford was performed by Chris Ryan, Director of Planning & Development, with very positive feedback.
- GB moved to offer the position to Ms. DaSilva-Conde at the highest allowable salary level (Grade 8, Step 2, \$19.87 per hour); DB seconded.
 - If unable to hire Ms. DaSilva-Conde, second choice is Rachel Richard of Leominster.
 - Motion approved unanimously.
- BD to forward a list of CA priority tasks, for Commission review.
- BD to notify candidates.
- Mr. Suhoski stated that the position does not require a criminal background check, and that the town does not have a standard procedure conducting such checks.
 - Commission can ask candidate to voluntarily agree to a background check.

• Possible Violation – 147 Oak Ridge Drive, Beach Construction

- Commission visited the McNulty residence to inspect their backyard beach on Sandy Pond.
- There is uncertainty re: conditions of the pond shoreline and yard prior to construction of the beach.
- BD to ask DEP for input on how to proceed.
- Continued Public Hearing Nashoba Valley Medical Center (NVMC)
 - NVMC filed an Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation (ANRAD) seeking approval of delineation of three separate wetland areas behind the hospital.
 - Commission conducted a site walk 09/08/07.
 - Wetland flags were either missing or unidentified.
 - Drainage issues remain unresolved.
 - GB moved to continue hearing to 09/27/07; DB seconded.
 - Motion approved unanimously.
