Finance Committee Minutes

Wednesday February 26, 2014

Call to order at 7:02pm by Scott Houde.

- > Review of Upcoming Expenditures/Town Counsel
 - RP Ms. Lewis will be retiring in 6/14; will need RFT for buyout of \$8,140.80.
 - RP Proposing salary of \$45,455.76, Grade 8 Step 2 (Please see 2/26 Memorandum)
 - RP Will be attending BOS meeting on Tuesday
 - RP Bolduc enterprises six figure request foes not include legal fees
- ➤ Review of ASRSD Budget
 - CM Increase of \$745k needed to offer what we have for FY14
 - CM Health insurance came in at 3.2% which will be a savings
 - CM Increase in cost of utilities
 - CM Teacher lane change of \$20k is a contractual arrangement
 - CM Lunenburg students down to five next year
 - CM \$8k in transport reimbursement expected to change
 - CM Will need increase in special education funding
 - CM Page Hilltop requires the most repairs
 - SH Possibility of borrowing UDAG funds for heating
 - EK \$750-800k for students coming to Ayer; pays for 12 teachers.
 - JK Is there a provision for OPEB?
 - EK No
 - SH Is Ayer paying a higher amount in the first five years or is it just a shift in liability? Ayer is paying \$1.5m more in first five years.
 - General discussion regarding potential reassessment of formula
 - SH Concerned with Ayer's ability to provide funding due to Shirley's inability to pay.
 - CM Reserves are inadequate. Repairs and a cold winter have played into exceeding the budget. The Facilities Coordinator has been a cobbled solution.
 - EK Would like to have greater oversight of custodial staff in the evenings (2nd shift)
 - CM We need \$200k more than what's in our budget for facilities repair
 - CM 50 hours per building in the summer months for a secretarial position; special education teacher needed at the high school; more teachers needed in the future due to class size. Assistant Principal position is needed; 50 staff, 400 kids.

- JK Is School Choice a fixed cost?
- EK \$5k plus special education costs add additional increment; \$6,000-\$6,200. School Choice has a statutory cap; charter school tuition is based on our cost (\$12,000 per student). 90 kids currently attending charter schools.
- SH Why is this so expensive?
- EK It's the formula that the state uses; we receive about 10-15% back in what we pay for charter schools.
- Review of FY15 Budget
 - LG Running \$29k deficit due to snow removal
- Non-Union Compensation Study
 - SH RP had extensive list of items not included in the study; anticipates receiving a revised version by Friday. Will be a factor for FY15 budget.
 - MS Can you put all revenue from meals tax to OPEB?
 - SH We would need a warrant article for that.
