### Green Community Grant I Update

- CM discussed demonstration of street lamp options LED vs. induction; color and direction of light varies
- GCC celebration has not yet been scheduled; CM suggested celebration might include tours of DPW and WWTP facilities

#### • Green Community Grant II Update and Future Projects

- Future Funding
  - The first round of grant funds will need to be exhausted before future funding is awarded.
- Residential Energy Efficiency
  - CM spoke to Worcester GCC regarding their efforts to help residential users with energy costs; the Worcester program is oriented towards encouraging builders to incorporate energy efficiencies into new projects
  - MassSave.com is an existing useful resource for residential energy users; energy audits available
  - Options for motivated individuals to pursue energy efficient improvements were discussed including low/no interest financing and the "Team" approach implemented by the St. Andrews Heat and Barn Raisers program
- Energy Awareness
  - JC will follow up on making information brochures available
  - Energy Committee and GCC websites are up to date with useful information
- Town Energy Contract
  - AW explained that the Town could achieve significant cost savings in negotiating a new energy contract; AW will follow up with Energy Committee discussion

# Solar Projects

- o Energy Committee has asked GCC to take the lead in pursuing solar energy projects
- FS mentioned St. Andrews had been contacted by Solar Bug solar installers for a possible rooftop installation
- Harvard was one of three GC to be awarded a "solarize" grant to assist home ownersin purchasing photovoltaic systems for their homes
- Members discussed options for making Power Purchase Agreements available to local businesses
- The town is preparing an RFP to purchase a photovoltaic system
