Barrington Conservation Commission (BCC) chair John Wallace called the meeting of December 1, 2016 to order at 6:17.

Wallace opened a public hearing to discuss funding the Barr conservation project, and explained the details of the project.

Melvin made a motion, seconded by Failing to:

Approve expenditure of up to \$110,000 from the Conservation Fund towards the purchase of a conservation easement on ~54 acres of the Barr property (tax map 219 lot 45). The conservation easement will be held by the Southeast Land Trust of NH, with the town holding an executory interest.

There was no discussion from the board. Wallace opened the hearing for public comment, and there was none. Wallace closed public comment.

The motion passed, 3 votes to none.

Melvin made a motion, seconded by Failing to:

Authorize expenditure of the \$150,000 expected from the New Hampshire Land and Community Heritage Investment Program (LCHIP) to be used towards the purchase a conservation easement on ~54 acres of the Barr property (tax map 219 lot 45). The conservation easement will be held by the Southeast Land Trust of NH, with the town holding an executory interest.

The motion passed, 3 votes to none.

Melvin made a motion, seconded by Failing to adjourn.
