## Possible zoning changes

- 1. Work Force Housing Have Jae review the work force housing hope to use the same model as was presented to the voters last March
- 2. Definition of Structure Page 78: Reword structures definition add catch all sentence that would include generators, air conditioners, outside furnaces, etc. Would like to allow installation of a generator, air conditioner, outside furnace etc to be installed without going before the Zoning Board if setbacks were not met
- 3. Article 5 Page 16: Word Nonconforming lots, Non-Conforming Lots, Structures, And Uses: Lots that would be equal swaps worded so that they would not have to go before the ZBA any other cases that would improve lot sizes could also be addressed. This could encourage increasing the size of non-conforming lots
- **4.** Address signs in the Town Center Need to set the sizes, lighting, requirements that would be allowed
- **5. Article 9 page 33 9.5.1- Exceptions for Constriction in Wetland Buffers**. Wells allowed in the 50 foot buffer as an exception included in Article 9.5.1
- **6. Article 9, page 33 9.5.1 Exceptions for Construction in Wetland Buffers -** Clarify driveways & roads allowed in the 50 foot wetland buffer
- **7. Article 9, page 33 .5.1.3 Exceptions for Costruction in Wetland Buffers -** Remove 303.04, as amended, that expedites certain types of wetland crossings may be permitted
- **8. Create a Definition of Jurisdictional Soils** Wording as presented last March, using the wording in the existing definition of Wetland Areas, page 80

Items 1, 6, 7, 8, & 9 were items that were presented last year

**9. Change Article 4 – Dimensional Requirements – Section 4.2.1** – minimum lot size for a dwelling unit – 80,000 square feet which must include at least 40,000 square feet of contiguous upland soil free of jurisdictional soils – do away with 80,000 square feet – 60,000 square feet – 35,000 square feet that was now required – Article 4, Page 12
