MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

1. Approval of the December 2, 2014 Meeting Minutes.

Without objection the minutes were adopted as corrected.

2. Discussion with Ashley Iber Amanti regarding possible participation in a mixed use charrette with the Workforce Housing Coalition of the Greater Seacoast.

Ms. Iber Amanti described the mission of the coalition was to be a catalyst for the development of a range of housing options affordable for the diverse workforce of the Seacoast Region of New Hampshire and Maine. The coalition gathered groups of housing professionals, property owners, municipal officials, and community members to look at the possibilities of workforce housing through workshops known as charrettes. Ms. Iber Amanti defined affordable housing as housing costing no more than 30% of a household's income. Workforce housing was described as providing homes for a wide variety of workers including: young professionals, teachers, municipal employees, and health care workers.

The Board expressed interest in holding a charrette which would occur sometime in the fall of 2015. Ms. Gasses would work with Ms. Iber Amanti on moving forward with the idea.

3. Discussion on Article 9 from the Zoning Ordinance.

<u>A. Gaudiello</u> explained that the latest revised version of the language was to make clear that sheds are not allowed in the wetland.

The Board had discussed the earlier language which would make it permissible for sheds and similar pole mounted structures, with a combined area of 200 square feet or less to be permitted in wetland buffer areas. The construction limitations (pole or peer mounted requirements) are consistent with the usual construction techniques of other structures permitted within the restricted areas without "special permitting". The size limitation was consistent with the building code size limitation on sheds not requiring a building permit. Also, ZO 9.4(5)(a) and ZO 9.4(5)(b) also applied and, in almost every instance the area involved was less than 1% of the buffer area.

<u>A. Gaudiello</u> explained the process for bringing the proposal to public hearing and to the warrant. The Board would post for a first public hearing on January 6, 2014.

A motion was made by <u>J. Pohopek</u> and seconded by <u>J. Bouchard</u> that the language in the document with revisions 1-A be presented for public hearing on January 6, 2015. The motion carried 6-1
