# Notes from 6/19/14 Communications Group Meeting (Envision Barrington)

#### I. Discussions

- 1. At the last meeting we identified an internet medium such as The Forum (forumhome.org) as a potential vehicle for communication. We invited Maureen Mann, from The Forum, to come speak with us and share information. Highlights of the discussion include:
  - The Forum started in 2004. The Forum is a website that serves Candia, Deerfield, Northwood, and Nottingham. Impetus to start was lack of communication, events with USA Springs, and the need to communicate to diverse audience.
  - They had similar path to solutions as our group is on..... lack of communication, wide audience, no twoway communication, etc. They had a small team (8) and decided to utilize a website. They did not have a budget.
  - They learned that J-Lab had grant monies and proceeded with writing a grant (she will share a copy).
    They were awarded a \$10,000 grant. The grant was submitted in February and the result was out by May; the first published newsletter went out in August.
  - They formed The Forum. They strive for non-partisan takes on all subjects. They do have an opinions section, along with local news, sports, arts & culture.
  - Currently they spend \$50 a month for the site. They take advertising revenue and they do conduct fund raisers.
  - Grassroots news effort team of about 8 to keep The Forum running smoothly.
  - In addition to the website, they publish a print edition and distribute it to approximately 7,200 addressees in the 4 towns through the Post Office Bulk Mail. (They use Seacoast Printers, postage and printing costs around \$3K.)
  - They conduct interviews with candidates running in the elections.
  - They have active subscribers (they send Blast Outs for events, news, etc.).
  - They continually solicit for articles, pull agendas from town websites, use Legacy for obituaries, receive SPCA contributors, etc.
  - They track site visitors.
  - Filed as a 501(c)(3). Pay annually for liability insurance (errors and omissions).
  - They have an active Board of Directors.

We will continue to communicate with and learn from Maureen.

#### 2. Other Business

Liz no longer with the group.

We had limited time for other business but Steve cited cable statistics and Paul talked about other website possibilities. I will collect numbers from them and repost in future minutes. Jacki reported out the Envision Barrington meeting (team needs to act as a sub-group of the town, publish meeting minutes within 5 business days of meeting, and post agendas (submit to town officials).
