1. Call to Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

Motion to request the Board of Selectmen approve a non-binding question regarding the possible allocation of up to \$60,000 in town funds for architectural designs in order to move to the next phase of the building project: **Ruhl/Krenesky**; *no discussion*; all aye.

<u>ACTION</u>: S. Dowdell and M. Melville will formulate a question to present to the Board of Selectmen for approval to be asked at the November election in order to gauge public support of a building project.
