VI. SUPERINTENDENT'S COMMENTS

Mr. Yamin gave a very brief overview of where the budget stood as opposed to where it is now. Mr. Yamin stated he feels the budget is good and in the best interest of the Region.

VII. PUBLIC COMMENT

Paul Cummings, resident of Beacon Falls, expressed concern with the reduction in the Music Department at WRHS. Mr. Cummings was curious to find out if there was any correlation between the reduction and scheduling conflicts. Mr. Yamin responded to Mr. Cummings' concerns and assured him that staff was not being reduced due to eliminating the program but that the cut was due to low enrollment numbers.

Pat Geary, resident of Prospect, was thankful for the 0% increase and is thrilled to see that the TAG program is back. Ms. Geary had some questions that were precipitated from reading the article in the newspaper regarding the cuts in the Special Education Department. Mr. Yamin responded with a brief explanation which included how transportation affected a savings and that resources were being reallocated. Lastly, Ms. Geary expressed disappointment in the low number of public attendees.

Ms. Feducia thanked the members of the public who were in attendance and also thanked the administrators for being present and available during this process.
