MINUTES

5. W Rodorigo presented the survey for IT prepared by S. Reichardt, out IT consultant. He identified the following items that require attention:
 - a. Off-site backup, he has presented a proposal;
 - b. Data retention requirements.
 - i. Some data on legacy systems must be preserved to satisfy pension requirements. We should explore options to down load this data so we can decommission our oldest server.
 - ii. T. Broesler will speak with P. Bartucca regarding retention of computer records.
 - c. T. Broesler will check what data is retained by the Point-n-Pay syatem and where the data is stored.
