# 1. Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance

R. Minnick indicated that he will be formally requesting that Toby's Pond be turned over to Parks & Rec. There was a brief discussion in the difficulty with that department doing the maintenance on another parcel in town with the shortage of staff to keep all the areas, i.e. Matthies Park, the Rec field, etc., clean and wellmaintained.
