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# Memorandum

Subject: Floodplain Regulations
Date: November 5, 2010

The amended floodplain regulations which were adopted this summer were based upon comments submitted from the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection. One of the provisions was contained within amended Section 53.6.2 which established the reference date of the Flood Insurance Maps as September 29, 2010. Subsequent to the adoption of the zoning regulations, the date was changed to December 17, 2010. Therefore the regulations should be amended again to reflect this date.

Therefore, I proposed the following zone text amendment to Section 53.6.2 of the zoning regulations as follows, with deleted sections in red crossed out and the additions underlined in blue.

### Section 53.6.2 - The basis for establishing the areas of special flood hazard:

The areas of special flood hazard are identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in its Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for New Haven County Connecticut dated <u>December 17 September 29</u>, 2010, accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIARM), dated <u>September 29 December 17</u>, 2010, and other supporting data applicable to the Town of Beacon Falls, and any subsequent revisions thereto, are adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this regulation. Since mapping is legally adopted by reference into this regulation it must take precedence when more restrictive until such time as a map amendment or map revision is obtained from FEMA. Areas of special flood hazard are determined utilizing the base flood elevations (BFE's) provided on the flood profiles in the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for a community. BFE's provided on Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) are only approximate (rounded up or down) and should be verified with the BFE's published in the FIS for a specific location.
