Robert Spear, 14 Lakeview Rise, Beacon Falls came forward and inquired about a punch list for Chatfield Farms that was given on Dec 15, 2011 to Kevin McDuffie. Town Engineer, Jim Galligan noted that there is a new Developer in place and that he is addressing the issues. 1)Watch Hill – Paul Crotta was present and gave the commission a progress report. Comm. Chadderton noted that he has been by the property and is impressed with the progress. Mr. Crotta is seeking 3 additional weeks to complete. A motion was made by Comm. J. Fitzpatrick and 2nd by Comm. B. Giglio to allow an additional 3 weeks to complete the site work. All in favor.

2)Chatfield I – Matthew Gilchrist, principal with EG Group, came forward and told the commission that since last month the wetlands has approved the curbs and sidewalks.

Mr. Gilchrist also noted that the punch list mentioned earlier was created before he was involved with the project. He is working closely with the association to make this a safe and beautiful community.

Jim Galligan asked that the items on the list be identified by who is going to address it, which will be done by the association and which will be done by Mr. Gilchrist.

3)Pond Spring – No activity

5)Trepka, 113-119 Main St. – Mike Horbal came forward for the applicant and presented a site plan revision, the retaining wall moves the building a little closer to the road which changes the parking. The amount of spaces will be the same, just moved. He stated that they have inland wetlands approval and that the 2 parcels will have shared parking. A motion to accept the application was made by Comm. J. Fitzpatrick and 2nd by Comm. R. Jurzynski. All in favor. A motion approve the revised site plan application with 4 conditions was made by Comm. south side of lot 119 2) Parking easement with access and egress for 113/119 created 3)retaining wall detail will be with Town Engineer final approval 4)finalize drainage easement with town attorney approval.
