## I CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chairman J. Fitzpatrick called the special meeting of the Beacon Falls Planning and Zoning Commission to order at 7:36 P.M. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

II <u>HI Stone – Extension of Earth Removal Permit</u> – Application P-2009-181 Kurt Jones from Civil One came forward and submitted the receipts from the Certified mailings to the surrounding property owners. He noted that they are still in Phase I and that all fees have been paid for that Phase. Phase II and III will be paid before work starts. For the record he noted that this is with regard to Lot 3, Alliance Circle.

## III <u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u>

The applicant submitted a written request for a 35 day extension of the public hearing.
