

TOWN OF BEACON FALLS JOINT BOARD OF FINANCE BOARD OF SELECTMAN MEETING MINUTES Tuesday May 18, 2010

CALL TO ORDER

S. Cable called the joint meeting to order at 8:55 P.M.

Present: BOF Chairman W. Hopkinson, Vice Chairman G. Smith, Board of Finance members L. Krepinevich and R. Doiron

Selectmen D. Sorrentino, M. Krenesky

- S. Cable recommended that they take this budget to referendum.
- W. Hopkinson asked if anyone wanted to see S. Feducia's cuts. M. Krenesky said that he looked at them and had been covered already.
- G. Smith motioned to present the budget that was presented at the Public Hearing to the Board of Selectman. R. Doiron 2nd the motion. W. Hopkinson, R. Doiron and G. Smith voted aye. L. Krepinevich opposed the motion.

Discussion: G. Smith said he was comfortable without making any cuts. L. Krepinevich noted that his opposition was because he believed the town wanted more cuts. R. Doiron commented that he does not believe the budget should have had any changes and would prefer the budget before the cuts. W. Hopkinson said that she is in agreement with that statement. S. Cable repeated that she recommends that the budget presented this evening to referendum on June 2, 2010 at Laurel Ledge school.

S. Cable motioned that the Board of selectmen send this budget to a referendum. M. Krenesky 2nd the motion. D. Sorrentino opposed the motion.

Discussion: M. Krenesky noted that since the people at the public hearing were told this was going to referendum, it should not be changed to a town vote. D. Sorrentino questioned if there was enough money in the budget for a clerk for the referendum. S. Cable said yes as they could do a transfer.

G. Smith motioned to adjourn the meeting at 9:05 P.M. L. Krepinevich 2nd the motion. All voted aye.
