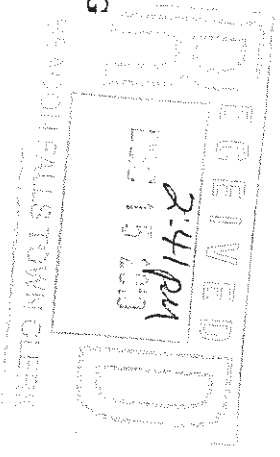


**TOWN OF BEACON FALLS
BOARD OF SELECTMEN PUBLIC HEARING**

DECEMBER 13, 2010

MINUTES



First Selectman S. Cable called the Public Hearing for Freedom of Information to Order at 6:00 PM.

Present: First Selectman Susan Cable, Selectman Dominic Sorrentino, Selectman Michael Krenesky

Public Present: William Stults, Laraine Weschler of the Citizens' News

S. Cable read the call of the meeting.

S. Cable asked W. Stults if he wished to go into an Executive Session. W. Stults stated he did not want to move into Executive Session.

S. Cable stated that based on the recommendation of W. Stults' former supervisor, the Board of Selectmen discussed the matter and made the decision to terminate W. Stults. W. Stults asked for the Selectmen's comments. M. Krenesky stated that the Board of Selectmen came to a conclusion and as a result of that and of the Selectmen not properly notifying W. Stults under the Freedom of Information ruling, the Public Hearing tonight is to take the actions necessary to complete the process. D. Sorrentino stated that he is in agreement with M. Krenesky and that the Public Hearing tonight is to correct the improper procedure that took place before. S. Cable concurred that the hearing is to rectify this matter.

W. Stults was asked if he wished to comment. He did not.

S. Cable read from the June 8, 2009 minutes where D. Sorrentino made a motion that W. Stults has violated his conditions of probation and has not lived up to the agreement he signed and be terminated effective immediately. M. Krenesky seconded the motion at that time. D. Sorrentino reaffirmed the motion. M. Krenesky reaffirmed his second to the motion. All ayes.

No further comment.

M. Krenesky made the motion to close the meeting at 6:05 PM. D. Sorrentino seconded the motion. All ayes.
