1. Call to Order/Pledge to the Flag

First Selectman Chris Bielik called the meeting to order at 7:04 P.M.

Members of the Pubic Present: 14 (2 more members of the public arrived after the start of the meeting)

2. <u>Purpose for the Town Meeting</u>

The Beacon Falls Board of Selectmen will hold a Special Town Meeting on Monday, July 11, 2016, beginning at 7:00 PM in the Town Hall Assembly Room, 10 Maple Avenue, Beacon Falls, CT, to discuss and vote on the following:

1. Transfer of \$30,750 from the FY 2015/2016 Contingency Fund (10-90-83-1170) to the Worker's Compensation Budget Line Item (10-90-13-1255)

3. Clerk Reads Call

C. Bielik asked for the temporary clerk to read the call. Marla Scirpo, clerk for the Board of Selectmen, read the legal notice for the Town of Beacon Falls for the Special Town Meeting as posted in the newspaper and as indicated in Agenda Item 2 in the Special Town Meeting minutes.

Motion to accept the call as read by the temporary clerk: **Tom Pratt/Martha Berge**;*no discussion*; **14 ayes**, **0 nays**, **0 abstentions**.C. Bielik asked for the public to verbally answer aye, nay, or abstain. There were no verbal nays or abstentions.

4. Nomination of Permanent Clerk for Town Meeting

C. Bielik asked for a nomination for a permanent clerk for tonight's town meeting. Mike Krenesky nominated Marla Scirpo and the nomination was seconded by Tom Pratt. C. Bielik asked three times for any other nominations. There were no other nominations for the permanent clerk and one ballot was cast for Marla Scirpo as the Permanent Clerk for tonight's town meeting.
