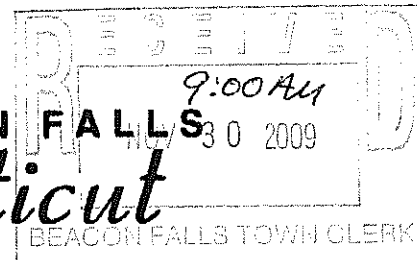

## INLAND WETLANDS & WATERCOURSE COMMISSION

### SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES, NOVEMBER 23, 2009

Chairman Stephen Knapik called the Regular Meeting of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourse Commission to order at 7:00 p.m.

#### **Chatfield Farms -- Reduction of Letters of Credit**

After site inspection by several of the Commission members, review of the request and a letter from the Town Engineer, Jim Galligan the Commission voted as follows:

**Motion was made by Commissioner Minnick and seconded by Vice Chairman Smith to reduce the Letter of Credit for the detention basins construction from \$75,000 to \$7,500 for maintenance. (Existing letter to be closed and a new letter issued. The soil erosion and sediment control Letter of Credit is to remain unchanged; (\$100,000 or \$150,000 -- amount to be verified).**
