



INLAND WETLANDS & WATERCOURSE COMMISSION

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES, DECEMBER 9, 2009 REVISED

Chairman Stephen Knapik called the Regular Meeting of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourse Commission to order at 7:30 p.m.

Mr. Rodrigo came before the Commission to discuss the swale on Pent Road which needs to be cleaned out. The proposal is to erect a steel building for maintenance equipment in the future which will be away from the watercourse. The Commission reviewed maps of the Pent Road Recreation Facility. The watercourse was originally six feet wide and three feet deep and has become overgrown. Currently, it is six to eight inches deep when it rains the water is to the road and floods the parking area and ball field. The proposal is to clean it out and put it back as originally constructed 20 years ago. Dave Keating, Wetlands Enforcement Officer stated if it was maintained every year, it would not be the major project it has become. He also feels that the building should be constructed further away from the watercourse. There is currently no maintenance agreement for the Pent Road Facility. Commissioner Minnick feels that when the berm is fixed this area should dry it and there should be no flooding.

Motion was made by Commissioner Minnick and seconded by Chairman Knapik that an application is to be submitted and the work is to be done with the guidance and supervision of the Town Engineer and the Wetlands Enforcement Officer. A maintenance agreement is to be submitted to the board.
