a. EG detailed the following Reserve Fund Transfer request:

i. Request to transfer \$25,000 from the Reserve Fund (acct # 01-941-5500) to Bonny Rigg Culvert (acct # 21-421 5500) to pay for unanticipated expenses to hold the water back while pouring footings. Acceptance moved by DP and seconded by MW. Passed unanimously.

4. Update on Ipswich Pharmaceuticals interest & plan for Sunnybanks Farm location

- a. EG provided an update on the latest proposal for the medical marijuana growing facility in Becket
  - i. The company is considering the purchase of part of Sunnybanks Farm (aprox.30 acres;
  - ii. The facility will be comprised of standard style greenhouses;
  - iii. Lighting at the facility will be minimal to lessen light pollution:
  - iv. The company, in addition to paying property taxes will provide the town with 2.5% of the gross sales and provide employment for local residents;
  - v. A yet to be scheduled meeting by the company will provide additional information on their proposal.
- b. DP moved to send a note to the BOS that the company's proposal has merit to provide the financial benefit per the wording of their letter. MW seconded. Passed unanimously.
