 - a. Police Department
 - i. Cruiser
 - 1. We are currently on 5 year rotation
 - 2. 845 Cruiser (2013 Interceptor SUV) has 132k miles
 - 3. Has cutout switch to avoid battery drainage
 - 4. \$13,872 total maintenance costs with last 2 years highest
 - 5. We had to add a new radio to the project
 - 6. We do a total of 80k total patrol mileage per year with our fleet
 - ii. · IMC Mobile Software Database
 - Records management system to get us current with balance of county law enforcement
 - 2. Sets us up for future needs
 - b. Highway
 - i. Backhoe (FY2019)
 - 1. 1999 with 8500+ hours
 - 2. Has had \$18k maintenance since 2016 and needs minimum of \$8k more
 - 3. Floor of cab is rotted out
 - 4. Replacing with same sized machine
 - 5. We should be storing all our equipment in a covered area for longevity
 - ii. Truck #2 is up next
 - 1. 2009 model
 - Maintenance cost to date about \$40k
 - 3. \$244k replacement cost
 - 4. Body swap is not worth the savings
 - iii. One ton dump and pickup
 - 1. Truck 1
 - a. 2013 model
 - b. \$7k maintenance to date
 - 2. Truck 5
 - a. 2011 1 ton
 - b. \$9700 maintenance to date
 - iv. Tractor possible in 2022/2023
 - c. Ambulance
 - i. New ambulance due August/September

- ii. Chest compression to meet new standard practices
 - 1. More effective and results in higher quality of life in after care
- iii. New evacuation chair
 - 1. Current was built in 2003 and is worn out/due for replacement
- iv. Operating we will drop the requested increase to \$30,000 (requested increase was \$42,927) but increase Reserve Fund \$10,000
- d. Fire
- Turnout gear
 - Useful life is 10 years and we need to replace old gear plus outfit new members
- e. Town Clerk
 - George Roberts requested we revisit the Town Clerk salary budget request for FY2019
 - ii. Salary is based on 24 hours/week and there are additional responsibilities outside of this time plus the hourly rate may not compare favorably to other town positions or other Town Clerks
 - iii. Also feels the town should consider making the Town Clerk job a 40 hour/week position and also creating an Assistant Town Clerk position
- f. Annual Town Meeting
 - i. BM has increases Town Meeting Expenses to \$6,000 to handle additional Special Town Meeting for Broadband
- g. Weed Center Pond
 - Volunteer group has asked for additional \$1,000 due to passing of Mercedes Gallagher (loss of volunteer effort)
- 5. General
