Road report:

Between May 17 to MAY 19, grade rake and roll was done on Longbow Ln. W., Long Bow Ln. E., Old Abbey, Robinwood , Shutlecock and Silver Leaf sec. 2&3.

Ernie has ordered the No Outlet signs, and will put them up when they arrive.

The sign at Golden Fawn will be moved.

Ernie will look at White's driveway to see what can be done.

There was a question about the location of the sand barrels, some of which will have to be moved, as they are in the way of the snow plows.

Mr. Mednik sent a letter complaining about the small stones being pushed onto his property during grade, rake, and rolling.

The road report was accepted.

Lakes report:

So far this year, the divers have completed approximately 20 hours. Two more days should finish Silver Shield Lake. Where the divers worked last year, the weeds are much fewer. Due to the number of divers we have, and because they are part time, not all areas can be covered. The divers do not pull up to the shoreline, so property owners are responsible for pulling their areas. Michael suggested that may-be Golden Fawn could be hand pulled.

The water at the beach has been tested, and the E-Coli count is acceptable.

The Lakes report was accepted.

Property update:

Grant Process:

Michael said he called about the FEMA grant, and we are good until June of 2016. Margaret has E-mailed all the documentation to Michael, and he will work with them.

Additional business:
