- Would relocate to the area which aids in ability to become involved in community and helps keep him in the position for longevity
- New to TA position which would lend itself to longevity in the Becket position

• Good mentor and connections in municipal government for guidance

Cons -

• No hands on experience as a Town Administrator

Bill moved to offer the Town Administrator's position to William Caldwell subject to reference and CORI checks. Michael seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
