

Belknap County Personnel Committee Public Hearing Minutes for the Non-Public Session on November 12, 2014 regarding Motion for Rehearing in discharge of Matthew Logue

At the Public Meeting held on November 12, 2014, the Personnel Committee voted to go into non-public session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II(a) to discuss and vote on the Commissioners' Motion for Rehearing.

Present at the non-public session were: Personnel Committee Members Colette Worsman and Robert Greemore and Attorney Lauren Irwin.

The Personnel Committee reviewed and discussed the objections raised by the Commissioners, to the Personnel Committee's decision to reinstate Matthew Logue. The three major categories are:

1. "The personnel committee's failure to find good cause for discharge on the basis of dishonesty is unlawful and unreasonable."

The committee members discussed the fact that there was no new evidence presented on this issue.

2. "The personnel committee's failure to find good cause for discharge on the basis of neglect of duty is unlawful and unreasonable."

The committee members discussed the fact that there was no new evidence presented on this issue.

3. "The personnel committee's failure to find good cause for discharge on the basis of willful insubordination is unlawful and unreasonable."

The committee members discussed the fact that there was no new evidence presented on this issue.

The committee members had discussed the fact that while there was some evidence of performance failures on the part of Mr. Logue, these failures did not rise to the level of good cause for discharge under RSA 28:10-a.

After reviewing the motion and the exhibits referenced and discussing the fact there was no new evidence, the Committee still believes its findings and decision were reasonable and lawful.

Upon motion by Rep. Greemore and Second by Rep. Worsman, the committee members voted to deny the Motion for rehearing 2/0.



