Departmental Update-Restorative Justice: Sharon Cavanaugh reviewed the update provided in the packets.

<u>Jail Inspection Report:</u> There was a discussion about the current conditions of the female living area and cost associated with relocating them to another facility. Commissioner Taylor would like the report to include the following: We hope that these issues are resolved, but because of lack of funding there is no assurance that the facility will open but in any event we will not continue to use these spaces for residential purposes. No actions were taken.

Request to Fill: Commissioner Waring stated he needed to see a funding source to cover the positions. No actions were taken.

<u>Natural Gas & Electricity Contract Authorization:</u> Facilities Manager Dustin Muzzey requested approval to allow USource to bid the Counties electricity and natural gas. Dustin will do more research and report back to the board. No actions were taken.

<u>Other:</u> Sheriff Moyer spoke about the department budget and not being able to guarantee the budget will not go over. Commissioner Waring suggested they stop outside details.

Superintendent Gray requested approval to purchase a training program for correctional officer certification. He stated the program would save money in wages. M/Waring, S/Taylor to approve the request to purchase the training program. Unanimous. **Motion passed**.
