5. TRANSFER OF FUNDS (CFO)

Marilyn Mathieu appeared to request two transfers. They are:

\$15,000.00 to be transferred from Debt Service/Interest on Bonds to Street Lights. The committee mentioned setting up a subcommittee to study street lighting (i.e.: un-need lighting, pull-boxes, etc.). Marilyn Mathieu will mention this to Denis Fraine. 1

¹ Response from Denis Fraine 7/6/2007: Marilyn did mention this to me and it is something we are currently going to look at through our Energy Conservation Task Force. This was a Committee formed by the Selectmen and School Committee last Fall. We are reviewing all of the Town/School energy demands and will be making recommendations at some point. The Committee is Chaired by Peter Morelli and he is joined by Roger Oakley, Dan Ranieri, Mike Muszicki and Bob Rousseau and I sit in as well. This Committee generally meets on the 4th Tuesday of the month.

\$9,500.00 to be transferred from Reserve Fund to OJI Account. There are still two employees out on OJI.

6. SCHOOL DEPARTMENT (No response to letter regarding Roof Repairs)

Marilyn Mathieu passed out a list of the School's capital projects. The FinCom will request a meeting with the School Committee regarding their capital projects.

The School Committee did not respond to the FinCom letter to them dated March 26, 2007 requesting information on the roof leaks at the South School. A follow-up letter will be sent requesting the information before the FinCom's next meeting.

The fire department will be looking for a new rescue.

Joseph Collamati wants to see a revolving fund-special legislation- for recovery for OJI reimbursements. Marilyn Mathieu will check with MA DOR regarding this.
