Mr. Anthony Padula came before the Board with a plan for the approval of same. The members of the Board voted to take it under advisement.

Mr. Sloane, a realtor from Boston, Mass., and Mr. Robert Schultz, C.E., from So. Braintree, came before the Board representing the East Coast Builders, Inc., of So. Braintree for a proposed development of 306 units to be located on Hartford Avenue. These men promised that our regulations would be completely followed. In some instances they promised to do more than ~~what~~ our regulations called for. The promised to used black-top roads instead of oil roads and to used the type II for water mains (cast iron with a cement lining inside). The members of the Board voted unanimously to approve their ~~(affix)~~ preliminary plan tentatively.
