Meeting of June 30, 1960

Four members were present: R. Richard

H. Cook, Jr.

Voted unanimously to approve the subdivision of Arthur Simoneau to be located on Blackstone Street.

The members of the Board signed the definitive plan of Roland Plasse of his subdivision to be located on Lake St., and to be known as Lake Street Manor.

Unanimously voted to have the clerk notify Mr. Richardson from the firm of Richardson & Brady, that in view of the fact that he had failed to leave copies of his proposed subdivision with us, and further in view of the fact that the Board of Health did not have copies, that his preliminary plan was was disapproved.

It was voted to have the clerk notify Mr. Melvin R. Asher, of Newtonville, Mass., that in view of the fact that he had failed to leave a deposit with us, and that he had himself failed to give (minimum) notice to the abutters of the time and date of the public hearing on his subdivision that unless he requested an extension of time we would have to disapprove his plan.

It was voted to have the clerk check with Mr. Trudeau, Town Clerk, on whether or not Wethersfield II had filed with him. If so it was voted to hold the public hearing on July 28, 1960.

Motion made by R. Richard and seconded by Emile DeRouin to asked for \$8,900.00 at the next special town meeting to complete the proposed zoning by-laws and map for the town. Said motion was carried.
