Several people were present for this hearing. The petitioner and his attorney, Mr. Eugene Tougas were present. Mr. Tougas spoke in behalf of the petitioner. The petitioner's civil engineer was also present and answered questions. No official action was taken on this hearing since there was some time left for the Board to act on this matter.

The scheduled public hearing on the proposed subdivision of Austin O'Toole on land located off Hartford Ave., of Mr. Couture, was held. The petitioner was present along with his attorney, Mr. Daly. The petitioner's civil engineer was also present to answer questions. Mr. Daly talked at length about the proposed subdivision.
