The Board voted to have \$750.00 to be held in escrow on each lot by Alfarm Realty's banks. No release will be given until the Board receives written notice that this has been done.

Projection figures were dicussed for the developement of new homes in the town of Bellingham within the next five years. If all estimated homes pending were built within the next five years, there would be 1486.

The motion to adjourn was made and so voted at 9:30 p.m.
