Public hearing held in the Bellingham High School on  
December 21, 1962.

The public hearing was held at 7:00 P.M. to discuss the  
proposed change in zoning as follows:

An area of land mostly zoned as an Agricultural District and partly as an Commercial District to an Industrial District; the said land being the land of Arthur J. Webster, along with certain other adjoining land located on the southerly side of Mechanic Street (Rte.#140) and the westerly side of Maple Street, more particularly bounded, northerly by said Mechanic Street, easterly by said Maple Street, southerly by land now or formerly of Wilfred Gosselin and westerly in part by land now or formerly owned by Annie Hutton, in part by land of Patrick, and in part by land of Charles M. Barsamian, and in part by land of Bernard Ledoux, and consisting of a strip of land eight hundred feet in width from the westerly side of said Maple Street and running from the southerly side of said Mechanic Street along said Maple Street 2,300 feet in depth.

Since there was no opposition to the proposed change at this Public Hearing it was unanimously voted in favor.
