Regular meeting of February 25, 1965.

Meeting called to order by the chairman of the board at 8:05.
Minutes were approved as read on a motion made by Francis J.
Prior and seconded by J. Eugene Corriveau.

Mr. Leo Millette requested release of streets from a recorded
"Covenant" but J.E. Corriveau and Francis Prior would not
sign the release because of a drainage problem in the Green
Acres development off Center Street. Mr. Delannoy scheduled
an informal meeting of the board members and Mr. Millette for
4:30 P.M. on Saturday at the development.

Roger Canestrari appeared as petitioner for Oswego Avenue.
On a motion of ~~Rene Delannoy~~ and seconded by Francis Prior,
it was unanimously voted to recommend the acceptance of 550
ft. of Oswego Avenue, beginning from Mann Street, in a north-
erly direction.

G. Bertrand Bibeault, C.E. , presented a deed for land of
Normand Belanger as had been requested. Plan signed by mem-
bers of the board for recording purposes. Land located on
Cross Street.

Mr. Bibeault was informed that the plan of Marion Simoneau
would have to be presented to the Brd. of Appeals because
Marion Rd. has not yet been accepted by the town. Mr. Dela-
nnoy said he would then recommend acceptance of the plan.

The board also informed Mr. Bibeault that it would reconsider
the plan of Henry Lemire off Wrentham Road which had been re-
jected because of insufficient information and notification
to the Tennessee Gas Transmission Co. Mr. Delannoy said he
would recommend acceptance of the plan providing it complies
with regulations from the Dept. of Public Utilities.
