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The following information was obtained from the records of the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management, for the year 1964.

The total number of acres of land in the State of Alaska, as of January 1, 1964, was 3,800,000 acres. Of this total, 1,200,000 acres were owned by the Federal Government, 1,000,000 acres were owned by the State of Alaska, and 1,600,000 acres were owned by private individuals or corporations.

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
