A plan not requiring approval was signed for land court
purposes. Plan was submitted for G.& B. Realty Trust of Milford
by Dominic Bozzini and showed a parcel of land located at the
corner of Maple Street and Mechanic Street containing 60.59
acres. Motion to sign the plan was made by Chase and (2) by
Daigle. Unanimous.

the clerk on a motion of Chase and (2) by Daigle. Unanimous.

to attend its next meeting to discuss Lisa Ann Dr. in regards
