Meeting of November 30, 1967.

Before a quorum of the board was present, Harold Beardsworth of Maple Street, No. Bellingham, discussed a water problem in his cellar created by what he termed was a broken pipe caused by builder W. Millette in the construction of the Ray Avenue roadway. Chase inquired if there was a record easement for the 5" pipe and was informed by Beardsworth that none could be found in the Dedham Registry nor any record as to its exact location; however, he said he would be protected by law under prescription. Daigle said he would ask Millette if he had any knowledge of the pipe or its location.

There now being a quorum, Vice-Chairman Robert Chase called the meeting to order at 8:15 P.M.

Minutes of the Meeting of November 16 and the Meeting of November 23 were approved as read by the clerk on a motion of Daigle and (2) by Andrews. Unanimous.

Roger Belanger was present at the meeting and requested signatures of the board for V.A. purposes but was informed by Chase that the letter lacked sufficient information and lot numbers would be required.

Approval was received from the Water Department relative to the Charlesgate at Bellingham Subdivision on Ray Avenue.

Notice was received from the Dept. of Commerce that a seminar would be held on December 11.

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 9:55 P.M. So carried.
