A copy of a statement was received from the Dept. of Nat. Resources as sent to Sanford Construction Co. in connection with the proposed bridge construction over the Charles River.

Neal D. Hannon, Planning Assistant, of Boston attended the meeting and the Comprehensive Plan of Bellingham was reviewed.

The budget for the coming year was completed by the board.
