In-coming correspondence was reviewed. Parisi urged members to attend a special conference at Dean Jr. College entitled "Route 495 Comes Alive". The meeting will include representatives from adjoining towns. Next Thursday's meeting of the Planning Board will be cancelled if members wish to attend.

A meeting on the study of Relocation and Widening of Rt.

Board went into a closed session. By a unanimous vote of the members present the chairman was given the power to elect a temporary secretary. Two applicants were present and submitted resumes. End of closed session.

Parisi notified members that the Water Dept. has scheduled the taking of aerial photographs of the town and in conjunction therewith, the Planning Board could request photos of the general center of town at a reasonable fee.

On a motion made by Beauregard and (2) by Daigle the board voted unanimously to request the Water Board to include two aerial photos of the center at Mechanic and Depot Street at a fee not to exceed \$30.00.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
