Chairman Parisi opened the meeting and dispensed with the regular order of business. There were no objections.

George Morin appeared with a new plot plan of Almo Heights#2 and on a Daigle-Beauregard motion it was unanimously approved.

Leo Gosselin came before the Board with two plans of property for purposes of recording in the Land Court. The first containing 11 acres on Chestnut Street owned by Herve and Jeannette Lariviere and the second 42 acres on North Street owned by Julian Verhoest. On a motion made by Daigle and (2) by Beauregard the board voted unanimously to approve both plans.

Gosselin asked for a covenant release on lots #1, 2, 3 and 4 of a plan of land entitled "Subdivision for Leo and Mary Poirier on Poirier Street. On a Beauregard-Daigle motion, the board voted unanimously to approve the release.

Clifford Grover was then heard on his proposal for a supervised camp site on No. Main Street. Carl Rosenlund and Robert Kingdon of the Zoning Board were present. Grover explained that he would supply water, electricity, toilet facilities and the camp site complying with all state regulations. Swimming and horseback riding will also be available. It was decided that Parisi would seek legal interpretation from Town Council as to which category Mr. Grover's proposal would best fit into.

Minutes of the July 17th meeting were approved as read on a Daigle-Beauregard motion.

Correspondance was read.
