Earth Removal Bylaw 3.) Planned Development 4.) Center study .With the agreement of the Board Herr will work with the Capitol Improvements Commettee during the year. Multi-Family rules and Regulations will be set up.

Donald Horan of the Park Commissioners asked if the Board would give its support in an effort to obtain a state sponsored skating rink. A minimum of five acres would have to be donated by the town. All members agreed to give their support and help in bringing the rink to Bellingham.

Phil Herr will bring with him next month another Earth Removal amendment. The proposal will be discussed when the amendment is received.

The firm of Rackermann, Sawyer & Brewster of Boston requested copies of Rules and Regulations on Subdivisions, an official map and the Master Plan. They will be informed that Bellingham has no official Map and the Master Plan is out of print. On a Daigle-Parisi motion, it was unanimously voted to make a copy of the Rules and Regulations and charge the firm \$2.00.

A Memo was received from the Massachusetts Department of Community Affairs on the subject of Underground Wiring.

Meeting was adjourned at 10:05 P.M. on a Parisi-Daigle motion. Unanimous.
