Special Meeting of May 14, 1970

Chairman Hart called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

Town Counsel Ambler presented a plan of land off Hartford Avenue for land taking for the Water Department. The plan included land as follows: Parcel #1, Lots 24 thru 27 of the old Kingswood Subdivision belonging to Austin O'Toole; Parcel #2 belonging to N. E. Power Company; Parcel #3 belonging to Marie and William Glockner; Parcel #4, Lots 14 and 17 to 20 of Kingswood; Parcel #5 belonging to John and Edna Embree; Parcel #6 belonging to the First Baptist Church; Parcel #7 owned by Varney and Parcel #18 unknown. Daigle made a motion to approve the plan for land taking for the Water Department, Approval not Required. Rotatori (2) the motion with Hart in agreement.

A second plan for land taking for the Water Department was also presented by Ambler. This consisted of Parcel A owned by John and Edna Embree, Parcel B owned by Austin O'Toole and Parcel C owned by Bernadette Couture. On a Daigle-Rotatori motion, it was unanimously voted to approve the plan for land taking for the water department. Approval Not Required.

Philip Herr sent four copies of the Zoning Map showing the newly voted Multi-Family Districts. Two copies will be sent to the Town Clerk.

Ambler presented the Board with his written comments on the latest revision of the Earth Removal By-Law. Herr will be sent a copy and asked for his comments.

On a Daigle-Rotatori motion it was unanimously voted to approve a bill in the amount of \$6.80 to James Hart for travel expenses incurred for the Annual Meeting of the Mass. Federation Planning Board on May 2, 1970.

Meeting adjourned on a Rotatori-Daigle motion. Unanimous.
