He said Audet wanted to get a letter from the Board waiving the drainage situation. Audet said he needed it to get his deposit back and wanted a letter saying that the Board denied his request to waive the drainage. Mr. Rosenlund suggested that Madison go to the Building Inspector and determine whether he needs a special permit and what category his proposed plan falls under.

A brief discussion was held concerning the articles on the Town Warrant. Mr. Rosenlund suggested that members strive to attend the Town Meeting.

On a Murray/Boiteau motion the Board voted 5-0 to adjourn.
