Re: Request for approval of amendments to Zoning By-Laws

Gentlemen:

I hereby certify that the following amendments to the Zoning By-Laws were adopted at the Special Town Meeting of October 4, 1968 (adjourned session of October 7, 1968):

- ARTICLE 1. Voted: That the Town amend Section 2500, Intensity of Use Regulations, by adding the following paragraph:
 "2550. Public Housing shall be exempt from the minimum requirements of Intensity of Use as set forth in Section 2600."
 The vote on the above was as follows:
 YES 104; NO 10; TOTAL 114; 2/3 of 114 being 76 the motion carried.
- ARTICLE 2. Voted: That the Town amend the Zoning By-Law as follows:

 Amend Section 2400, Use Regulation Schedule, by adding footnote 6
 to Residential uses; Dwelling, Multi-family, public housing."

 "6. Except that multi-family shall not include public housing."

 The vote on the above was as follows:

 YES 104; NO 7; TOTAL 111; 2/3 of 111 being 74, the motion carried.

5) the hearing above referred to was held on October 4, 1968 at 7:00 PM.
