I hereby certify that the following motion was adopted under Article 10 by voters of the Town of Bellingham at the Special Town Meeting of February 14, 1979:

ARTICLE 10. ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

VOTED: Unanimously voted that the Town amend the Bellingham Zoning By-Law by amending the Zoning Map, rezoning from the B-1 District to the B-2 District approximately 7.6 acres, located near the intersection of Mill Street and North Main Street, appearing as Lot #1 on a plan entitled "Subdivision of Land owned by Thomas S. Clark," dated June, 1978, and filed with Town Clerk, being some but not all of Lot #45 on Assessor's Sheet #45.


