- **2. Broomfield, 164 Still River Road (112-613).** Brian Berube opened the continued hearing. Present was Greg Roy, P.E. of Ducharme of Dillis Civil Design Group, Mr. Roy, representing the applicant described the project and explain the projects history, he also discussed the drainage.
