Discussion: Since the April 4 meeting, Paula had worked with town staff to get copies of the electric and oil bills for all town buildings. All in attendance agreed we should create a central repository for this data. It was suggested that we split up the work and input the energy usage data into a spreadsheet. Chinloo volunteered to create a template. Members of the committee (Chinloo, Kevin, and Paul) split up the buildings and agreed to input the data into this template.

In addition, the Committee discussed three different outreach approaches:

- 1. Mike volunteered to meet with Curt Plante's cousin to discuss the possibility of this person (trained by Al Gore's Inconvenient Truth organization) giving a presentation to town residents regarding climate change. The group discussed the idea of reserving the high school auditorium, working with a science teacher who teaches a renewable energy unit (Paula knows this person) and promoting to students and their parents in order to get a good turnout. to put this event on before mid June.
- 2. The Committee Members also discussed MTC's Clean Energy Choice program which offers matching grants to towns when residents and organizations (municipalities, businesses, nonprofits, etc.) pay a premium for clean renewable sources of energy. Members discussed the idea of promoting at the upcoming

town meeting. Laura and Martha agreed to work on a one page handout and, since neither one would be able to attend the May 7 town meeting, Mike volunteered to make an announcement and bring sign up cards and copies of the one-page handout to the meeting. Paula volunteered to check with the Town Moderator to make sure it was OK for Mike to make the announcement.

3. Kevin will contact the DPW and work with Shelly to adverstise the waste oil furnace system the DPW uses to heat the garage.
