- Shared System and Nitrogen Aggregation fees proposed Amendment to the Board of Health Fees Established Regulation.

- Tobacco Regulations Letter from Hudson Board of Health.
 - o C. Slade stated education is more important than changing the age. C. Rogers and S. Powell agreed.
 - Board decided not to raise the age to 21 at this time.
 - o Board would support Hudson's effort to approach the State to change it at that level.

 - P. Bentsetler looked into the potential resources Montachusett Public Health Network could provide to see if it would be cost effective.
 - S. Powell asked if there is any insight into the high cancer rate.
 - P. Bensetler stated she will add the goals that the State has asked them to add and will send us a new copy.
