6:15 pm Jack Maloney of Ducharme & Dillis, CME Inspection Reports

- Board reviewed inspection reports for the first round of shared system inspections that have been completed so far.
- J. Maloney reported that some of the access points that should be to grade are not to grade.
- Typically there was one cover over the tank and one over the pump chamber. Any with filters were clogged. The overall health of the systems are good. Alarms are working.
- There is one lot that he was not able to get into the tank or septic chamber. Homeowners will be getting a contractor to get it excavated.
- J. Maloney recommended that the Board send a letter to the homeowners to bring the access points to grade.

6:30 pm Sarah Mortimer, 173 Harvard Road

- S. Mortimer presented a plan for a future proposed addition for the Board's input.
- Board determined the room count of the proposed layout to be 9 rooms total. Exisiting septic system is designed for 3 bedrooms.
- Major change would be losing one bedroom and adding two bedrooms over the garage. The number of occupants in the house would not change.
- The system passed Title 5 in 2005.
- Board has no issues but recommends a Title 5 Inspection.

6:40 pm Jack Sargent, 306 Old Bay Road

- Mr. Sargent representing the Clouter family was seeking exclusion from Title 5 as land is redistributed amongst family members. If property is divided or combined the exclusion does not apply.
- The old house was cut out of the property in 1996 but now they want to add some land back to that house.
- There is a septic system on the property that doesn't meet the groundwater offset based on mottling. It
 was never tied to anything.
- Based on mottling the cesspool would likely fail Title 5.
- The Board determined that the intent of the regulation is clear and rules should be applied equally.
- A Title 5 will be triggered on the cess pool.
