Bolton Historical Commission Meeting Minutes September 18, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 6:12 PM. The meeting was deemed informal as a quorum was not present.

- 1. The review of the minutes of the September 4 meeting was deferred
- 2. Progress on the Fyfeshire Lower Dam renovation was discussed briefly.
- 3. Morse Dam tree removal was discussed; the actual work is awaiting frozen ground so that it can be performed with minimum site impact.
- 4. The status of the Houghton Building siding RFPs was discussed. As there is no information as to the level of completion of either the siding replacement or refurbishment RFPs, Martha will follow up with the DPW Administrator.
- 5. Approximately 19 NRHD plaque responses have been received; most have indicated an interest in obtaining plaques. A meeting is planned with the selectmen on 10 October to discuss obtaining plaques for the Town buildings located in the historic area.
- 6. The tentative proposal to turn over RT 117 maintenance to the state DPW was discussed. It appears that this would have minimal impact on the Town and the Historic District, but additional information is needed to confirm this.
- 7. The request for a demolition permit for the garage at 313 Green Road was reviewed. Because the structure in question was built in 1975, its demolition need not be approved by the Historic Commission and the Town Secretary will be so informed.
